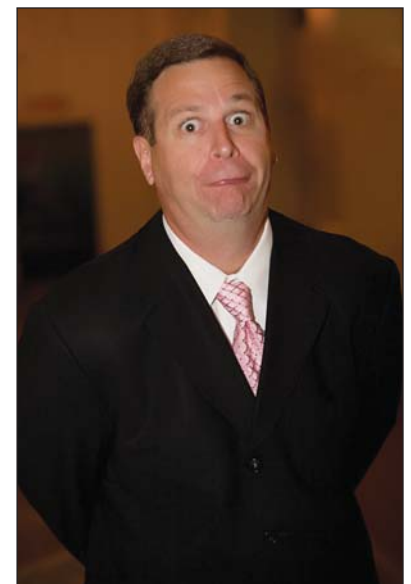

Members are reminded to bring their registration cards to receive AEC’s free gift and be eli-

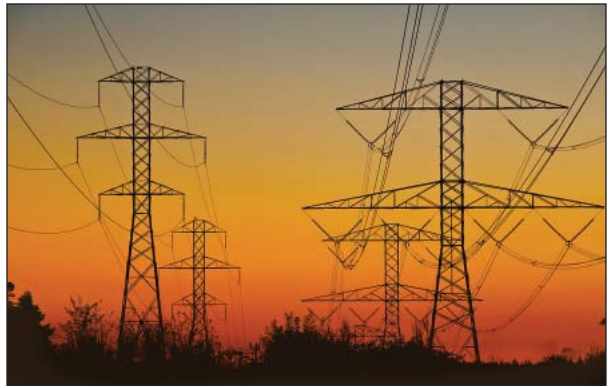

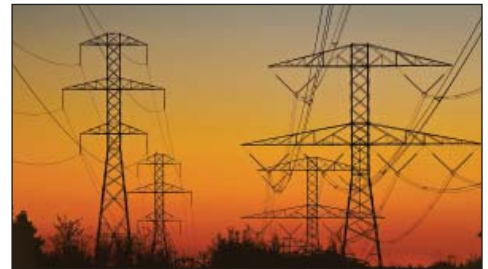
